William “Bill” J. Fedorko, of Palmyra formerly of Bluffton, SC passed away peacefully on Monday, December 30, 2024 at his residence surrounded by his family. He was 98.

Born in Manhattan, NY; the son of the late William and Martha (Maruschek) Fedorko. On March 17th, 1951, he married the love of his life Dorothy (Sporn) Fedorko. They celebrated 63 years of marriage until her passing in 2014. They were blessed with six children, 12 grandchildren, and 9 great-grandchildren. Dorothy and Bill enjoyed their retirement years in Sun City, Bluffton, SC.

Bill had so many hobbies and kept himself busy throughout his life. He proudly served in the United States Navy from 1947-1954. He was a midshipman during World War II and then graduated from the Maritime Academy where he received his commission in the Navy, in the Merchant Marine and the Maritime Service. He graduated from Michigan State University in 1959 with a Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine. He opened the Schoolhouse Animal Hospital in Burlington and retired after 30 years of service. He was one of the founders of Columbus Central Veterinary Hospital in Columbus NJ. He was an active member of the Rotary Club since 1962. He was the past president for the Willingboro Rotary Club (1969-1970) and Okatie Rotary Club (2004-2005). He received 2 Paul Harris Fellow awards.

Bill is survived by his children, Karen (husband Recep Sefer), William Jr. (wife Laura), Janice (husband Glen Krogh), Stephen Fedorko, Amy Warkoczewski, and Nancy (husband David Kerns).
