



## William F. Gardner

February 12, 1929 - July 4, 2018

William F. Gardner, a lifelong resident of Mount Holly, passed away on Wednesday, July 4, 2018 at the Fountains at Cedar Parke in Atco. He was 89. Born in Croydon, PA; the son of the late Charles and Edna (nee Dierolf) Gardner.

William was a graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School in 1948. After high school, he joined the U.S. Marine Corps until he retired as a Gunnery Sergeant in 1968. While in the Marines he received the Purple Heart for injuries sustained during the Korean Conflict. He also served in the Viet Nam War. After his retirement from the Marines, he worked for the U. S. Postal Service until his retirement in 1990. Bill had many hobbies including golf, playing cards, horseshoes, caring for his yard and home, but nothing ever took precedence over his devotion and sense of responsibility to his family.

He is survived by his wife of 67 years, Margaret (nee Moller); children, Keith (Pamela) Gardner and Donna (Kevin May) Gardner; grandchildren, Colin (Lisa) MacFarland, Amy (Todd) Salzwedel, Maggie Gardner, Mary Sedar, and Rachel Gardner; great-grandchildren, Colin, Brody, Brayden, Taylor, Matthew, Bella, and Amiyah; brothers, Charles and Frank Gardner; a former daughter-in-law, Sharon Sheldon; numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins. He is predeceased by a grandson, Cody Gardner.
