William Malovetz, 87, died peacefully on March 20, 2021.

Born on August 31, 1933 in Carteret, NJ, he lived there until moving to Columbus, NJ in 2005. Bill was a 1951 graduate of Carteret High School and son of the late Emil and Ann (Hamadyk) Malovetz. He graduated from the Drake Business School, and was employed as an accountant for the Carteret Board of Education until his retirement in 1998.

He received the nickname “Lefty” in his youth, not only because of his dominant hand but also for his athletic prowess on the basketball court. Throughout his life Bill had a great interest in sports.

For many years Bill was an active member of Saint Demetrius Men’s Club in Carteret, including their Dart League and Bowling League. While he lived in Carteret, Bill was a faithful member of Sacred Heart Roman Catholic Church.

His family will remember him as a devoted son, loyal brother and a favorite, loving uncle. He found great joy in family events, trips to casinos and weekly scratch off tickets. We counted on his pirogies each Christmas and his presence at our tables. He knew and shared the stories of our family history. Bill was an important part of our lives and will be missed for longer than we can imagine.
