William J. Wagner passed away Wednesday, November 26, 2014 at his residence in Mount Holly. Born in Teaneck, NJ, raised in Flemington, NJ before settling in Mount Holly. He was a US Army veteran that served during the Berlin Cold War. He was instrumental in the evacuation of American and Vietnam civilians after Saigon fell in 1975, for Evergreen Airlines (formally Air America). He worked for Northwest Orient Airlines. Most recently Bill worked and retired from the State of N.J. Division of Motor Vehicles.

Bill was active in politics in both Hunterdon & Burlington Counties. An active member of the Burlington County Republican Club, and as a member of the Republican Committee representing the 2nd Election District in Mount Holly. He enjoyed playing and watching golf, working on computers and summers on Long Beach Island and could often be heard humming along with Hawaiian music. He was an avid history buff and was especially knowledgeable about WW II.

Preceded in death by his parents Eleanor and Hans Wagner and a brother, Robert Wagner. Bill was dedicated to his family and married for 45 years to his love Kathleen. In addition to his wife, Bill is survived by his son Jon & wife Jessica; daughter Wendi Faul & husband Bradley and five granddaughters, Abigail, Kathleen, Shannon, Erin and Carolina Rose with whom he especially loved playing and sharing adventures.
