



William B Warren Sr.

April 12, 1945 - August 27, 2019

William B. Warren, Sr. of Lumberton passed away peacefully, surrounded by his family on Tuesday, August 27, 2019 at Virtua Hospital in Marlton. He was 74.

Born in Newport News, VA, Bill was a longtime area resident and a graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School where he played football on a championship RV football team. After his graduation, he served in the US Navy during Vietnam. He was a retired splicer for Verizon Communications. Bill was a Life Member and Past Captain of the Lumberton Emergency Squad, where he was an active volunteer for over 30 years as an EMT, rescue tech, Line Officer and Treasurer. He was also an EMT and CPR instructor for the Burlington County First Aid Academy. Bill was also a past OEM Coordinator for Lumberton Township for 15 years. Bill was also a member and Commander of the Westampton American Legion Post 509, Adjutant for the Westampton AmVets Post 79 and Assistant Adjutant for the Burlington County Executive Committee of the American Legion. He was an amateur radio enthusiast, a member of the Burlington Co. Radio Club, and a Burlington Co. RACES team member. He was known far and wide in public safety circles, and attended and supported many local events through the years.

Bill is survived by his wife Lynn; 3 children: Bill Warren, Jr. (Stacey), Karen Muraresku (Chuck), and Stephen Warren (Melissa); and 9 grandchildren. Funeral Services will be held on Saturday, September 7 at 11:00 AM at St. Andrew's Church, 121 High St., Mount Holly. Interment with military honors
