



## William P Naulty, Sr.

August 8, 1936 - January 7, 2010

William P. Naulty Sr., of Cinnaminson, NJ died Thursday January 7th, 2010 at Penn Presbyterian Medical Center in Philadelphia. He was 73. Mr. Naulty was born in Philadelphia and was a graduate of West Catholic Boys High School. He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. After his release from the Army he was a reporter for the Philadelphia Bulletin for over thirty years. After the Bulletin closed, he became Chief Legislative Aide for the Republican Legislators in the 8th District of New Jersey, a position he held for over 20 years. Mr. Naulty was a member of the Philadelphia Press Association and Deerwood country Club in Westampton, NJ . He was a member of Sacred Heart Church in Riverton, NJ.

Husband of the late Marie, Mr. Naulty is survived by two children, William P. Jr. and his wife Nancy of Voorhees, NJ, Marie Ritchie and her husband Stephen of Barrington, NJ and three grandchildren: Erin, Seamus and Braden with Colin on the way.
